**In the Diocese of Southwestern Virginia** pray for God's blessing on our diocese's higher education ministries.

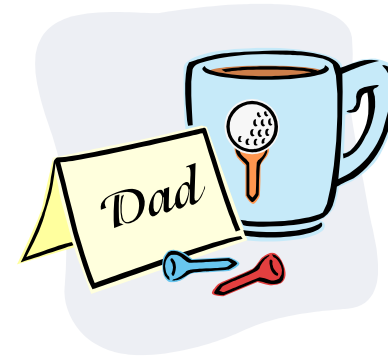
