- discussed a budget process for 2008 with greater input from program managers and others
- heard reports from the Rector and Wardens, including an update on physical plant projects under consideration - the planning committee will be meeting to review and make recommendations
- recognized Billy Bowles, Nancy Hoback, and Judy Phillips, members of the Furnishings Committee, for their work in furnishing the Post House and getting it ready for the Garden Club visit on May 20th
- recognized the efforts of Linda Hall, Camille Senter, Martha Ann Higginbotham, Diane Washenberger, Bob

McClanahan, Ed Cord, Jim Washenberger, Steve Bast, Bob Leary, John Hall, Jim Arnold, Bill Senter, Eric Pellant, and Tom Bird to clean and spruce up the building and grounds in preparation for the Garden Club tour, noting in particular Bob McClanahan's contribution of eight beautiful dwarf English boxwoods for the front of the church
